**Presentation:** Awards will be presented to the first 3 placegetters in both individual and pairs categories, and to the Champion Primary and Secondary schools.

**Other:** One week prior to the Championships, participating schools and individuals will receive final instructions, including directions to the event, final event information, control cards, control descriptions and a blank copy of the map for familiarisation.
